



Return to Work Carers

Information for Employers & Organisations

It is now more important than ever to help North of Tyne residents be able to move into work. This lies at the heart of our aim to create a more inclusive economy.

The North of Tyne Return to Work Carers pilot is one of our first initiatives to do this. The pilot will help residents who have caring commitments, but want to find work, access a range of routeways to local jobs.

Newcastle Carers, North Tyneside Carers Centre, and Carers Northumberland have worked with NTCA to develop a pilot that best meets the needs of local carers and gives local employers a pool of potential recruits and a diverse workforce.

Advisors will engage with local carers, assess their needs, support them to prepare for returning to work. The first step will be a work-based opportunity with a suitable employer. This will be done in ways that meets the needs of both returners and employers.

What does a return to work opportunity look like?

These opportunities will vary from organisation to organisation but could include CV evaluations, mock job interviews, one to one or group-based industry presentations, workplace visits and tours, work experience, internships or access to open vacancies.
