The Chief Executive is requested to approve/authorise

1. Procurement of a provider to deliver a climate change intervention for Key Stages 2&3 in 12 schools between April and December 2023 focusing on the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal 13 (Climate Action) to the value of £38,000
2. Sponsorship of the climate change activities relating to the Bring It On exhibition and event in October 2023 to the value of £5,000
3. Procurement of a provider to deliver 3 Games Challenge sessions for Key Stage 5, aimed at raising the awareness of climate change through computer games design to the value of £1,400

Delegation:

In the Delegated Decision Report dated 1 April 2020, approval was given to NTCA's Energy, Green Growth and Climate Change – a North of Tyne Blueprint, which set out a bold programme of investment, collaboration and change to support carbon reduction, clean growth and a new generation of jobs. Appendix 3 of that report – Climate Emergency and Supporting Communities to Reduce Carbon Emissions of the Blueprint - set out the need for NTCA to champion, influence and raise awareness of climate change action and green growth, a budget of £100k was approved to develop the propositions which will support this work.
