3, North East Devolution	<p>The Mayor and Cabinet:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. considered the report; 2. agreed in principle that they consent to the making of the statutory order under the Local Democracy, Economic Development and Construction Act 2009 to deliver the following proposals: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) the abolition of the two existing combined authorities, namely the North of Tyne Combined Authority (NTCA) and the north East Combined Authority (NECA); and b) the creation of a new mayoral combined authority which covers the area of all 7 councils, which will be called the North East Mayoral Combined Authority (NEMCA); 3. authorised the Chief Executive, in consultation with the Mayor, to issue consent on behalf of the Mayor and NTCA to the Secretary of State when requested; 4. authorised the NTCA Chief Executive, in consultation with Mayor, to finalise the terms of the side agreement regarding the support arrangements associated with these proposals; and 5. authorised the NTCA Chief Executive to take all other steps necessary to implement the proposals.
