

A core focus of the North East Create Growth Programme is supporting businesses in planning for and securing investment to enable growth.

Businesses will have tailored support to make them investment ready and have the opportunity to pitch to investors.

Businesses can be classed as 'high-growth potential' if they are able to demonstrate the following:

- Turnover growth of 10% year-on-year over approx. 3 years
- Employing a minimum of 2 people over the last two years
- Created a revenue generating product, launched a new platform or service or reached a market of scale
- Generated a sales revenue in the last 2 years.

#### **Funding**

Innovate UK are an investment partner in the national Create Growth programme and run funding competitions to facilitate business growth. Targeted finance will be provided to selected businesses who can demonstrate that they are investment ready and can grow through leveraging further private investment.

#### **Business Support**

The programme offers bespoke business support that is tailored to the specific needs of high-growth potential creative businesses, with the aim of building business management skills and understanding the different finance routes to support business growth and investment readiness.

Support initiatives include a suite of workshops, (covering topics such as Intellectual Property, business models and access to new markets), as well as one-to-one mentoring and peer learning.



#### **Investment Bootcamps**

An opportunity for cohorts of 20 high-growth businesses. This intensive 6-month course offers a comprehensive suite of tools to help founders assess their businesses, craft growth strategies, establish investment objectives and network with potential investors. The programme is designed to be flexible, with tailored 1-2-1 sessions and peer group sessions. By the end of the programme, each participant will be able to take their business to new heights with newly developed knowledge and skills.

A series of engaging events designed for creative businesses to gain valuable insights into the programmes available and learn how to access support. These events will provide an opportunity to connect with regional Creative UK team members and engage in conversations to learn more about what support is available to help your business grow.

#### WHAT'S THE PROGRAMME?

The package of support aspires to develop a vibrant screen industry in the North East by integrating various sectors and promoting diversity and inclusiveness.

Funded by the North East Screen Industries Partnership, support includes:

- A Film Service: to attract production companies to film in the region
- A North East Production Fund: to increase the number, quality and diversity of film and TV productions produced in the region
- A Skills and Education Service: to support new entrants into the industry and to up skill existing employees to support career progression
- **Business Development and Support:** to support sector growth in the region

North East Screen is North East England's screen industries development agency.

Working with emerging professionals, homegrown filmmakers and production companies specialising in film, TV and screen-based arts, developing them through their North East Screen Crew Academy and Talent and Business Development programme. Through their Film Office, they support film and TV production shooting anywhere in the region, providing a free and invaluable resource to maximise the benefits of filming in the North East.

North East Screen currently works in partnership with the region's local authorities and combined authorities, and has links to commissioners, production companies and TV networks, all to make the North East a Filming Friendly region for all productions.



#### **BUSINESS SUPPORT & PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT**

North East Screen hosts a number of networking events, workshops and bootcamps designed to support those in the industry. From signposting to funding opportunities and support on pitch development to ensuring your business is fit for purpose and commission ready.

#### **FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES**

There are various support initiatives and funding options for both crew and production companies based in the region.

#### **North East Production Fund**

Open to both local and national companies, the fund aims to catalyse the sustainable growth of the region's film and TV production sector by investing in a portfolio of distinctive, high-quality projects that will collectively contribute to the North East region increasing the on-screen visibility and actively contribute to employment of locally based crew, spend in region and improved equality, diversity and sustainability.

#### **REACH Development Grant Awards**

REACH Film and TV Development Grant Awards are designed to fund the development phase of exceptional film and television projects and support the growth of eligible SME creative businesses based in the North East of England.

Successful projects need to be high-quality, viable and capable of taking your work to the next level. Projects should have a viable route to production and support the creative and professional development of writers, directors, producers, craft and technical talent based in the North East.

#### **Going Places (Bursary Fund)**

Going Places is a bursary fund that supports travel and accommodation costs for North East based professionals starting out in film and TV aiming to overcome socioeconomic and geographical barriers.

The fund supports those with less than two years experience in the film and TV industry who have secured short term unpaid work experience, trainee placements, interviews held outside of the north east, training and networking opportunities.

Awards will be between £100 and £500 for a maximum of six weeks.

# CULTURE AND CREATIVE ZONES

#### **WHAT'S THE PROGRAMME?**

A CCZ is a designated area set up to support people and grow businesses working in the cultural and creative industries, providing a supportive and attractive environment for cultural and creative businesses and people to locate, start-up, grow, and flourish.

Delivered by the local authorities of Newcastle, North Tyneside and Northumberland, in partnership with local creative and cultural organisations.

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#### **WHO IS THIS FOR?**

Businesses and individuals in the North of Tyne CCZ area working, or aspiring to work, in the creative or cultural industries.

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#### **HOW DO I ACCESS?**

Each Zone is at a different stage of development. Opportunities will be shared by each Zone and local cultural partners.

The North of Tyne Culture and Creative Zone (CCZ) Programme is a new programme that aims to establish a supportive and attractive environment for creatives and cultural businesses to locate, start-up and grow.

Three CCZs have been awarded funding from the NTCA for five-year pilot projects:

- Creative Central: NCL, Newcastle upon Tyne
- · North Shields Cultural Quarter, North Tyneside
- · Create Berwick, Northumberland

The CCZs will provide an access point to support and encourage collaboration within the sector. This will ensure that no matter where in North of Tyne an independent artist, creative professional or business is located, they will have access to the networks and support to enable them to grow.

This approach will support the growth of the sector, helping artists, creatives and cultural businesses to connect with like-minded professionals, offering support for business growth, skills development programmes and networking opportunities.

Each Zone is developing a tailored programme of support which typically includes:

- provision of affordable creative workspace
- · access to business support
- skills development opportunities
- · engagement with local communities

## CREATIVE CENTRAL:

**NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE** 

#### Where is it?

Newcastle city centre's conservation area, from Grainger Market in the North to the Centre for Life in the South, The Common Room in the East and the Discovery Museum in the West.

#### What is the aim?

To create a vibrant, distinctive creative district where artists, creatives, cultural practitioners and creative businesses can start, grow and establish themselves as sustainable contributors to the creative and cultural landscape of the city.

#### What's next?

- A small grant scheme supporting the development of creative workspaces
- 12 creative skills and business support pilot projects
- Collaborative projects with Newcastle College, Newcastle University and Northumbria University
- An engagement strategy incorporating an artist in residence programme and micro commissions.

# NORTH SHIELDS CULTURAL QUARTER NORTH TYNESIDE

#### Where is it?

The heart of North Shields, from Northumberland Square in the town centre down to the Fish Quay, with a particular focus around the crossroads of Howard Street and Saville Street.

#### What is the aim?

To provide affordable work and performance space for a new creative cluster, along with business support to enable creative enterprises to flourish, regenerating this historic part of North Shields and attracting visitors.

#### What's next?

Development of the Exchange, Globe Gallery and Cultural Business Centre has begun. Generator NE have been appointed to deliver bespoke business support, Helix Arts has been appointed to develop a programme of mentoring and peer networking, a cultural and creative grants programme has been launched, & cultural organisations are being invited to shape an events programme.

#### CREATE BERWICK NORTHUMBERLAND

#### Where is it?

Within the historic walls of Berwick's town centre, between The Maltings and Berwick Barracks.

#### What is the aim?

Through innovative culture-led regeneration and by nurturing creative communities, Berwick will be a thriving creative hub that invests in community, creative practitioners and cultural organisations to generate new opportunities and experiences.

#### What's next?

A new Cultural Investment Plan is being launched, along with a Creative Skills and Business Development programme for creative practitioners, cultural organisations and communities. Working with local partners a new cultural events programme will celebrate Berwick's unique heritage and attract visitors, while pop-up creative spaces will reanimate the town centre and drive demand for a new creative studio and resource hub.

## MAKING CREATIVITY WORKS

- Improving diversity in the screen sector
- Providing practical training to build skills, confidence and knowledge

Making Creativity Works is a training course led by industry experts helping to equip people with the skills they need for a career in film, television or video production.

Delivered by Signpost Productions, which is part of ITV and Beacon Films, two North East production companies that work with deaf, hearing, disabled and non-disabled screen creatives.

The programme aims to improve diversity in the screen sector and offers over 100 hours of hands-on training giving people the skills, confidence and knowledge to develop a career in the industry. It includes a series of production based modules, no previous experience is necessary.

Some of those taking part in Making Creativity Works are expected to gain paid employment, others may get work experience and some will be signposted to higher and further education or further training.

Delivered in partnership with Newcastle University, this artist development work is sectorleading and needs-based. The programme offers pathways for freelancers to develop high-level skills in creative arts practice through a range of initiatives, activities and bursaries. The skills development work is delivered through three core programmes:

- Create/Disrupt, for creatives and aspiring creatives with no formal education interested in pursuing a career in the arts.
- The Collective Studio, a graduate development programme for recent graduates and creatives with no formal education working at an equivalent standard.
- Practice Makes Practice, an artist career development programme developed by artists for artists.

To remove financial barriers, the programme also offers bursaries for membership and placements.

#### **EVENTS**

The North of Tyne Combined Authority has proudly supported a diverse range of cultural events, with packed calendar planned for the near future.

#### **Great North Run 2021**

The Great North Run is the biggest half marathon in the UK with over 57,000 runners taking part in the iconic event.



#### North of the Tyne, Under the Stars

North of the Tyne, Under the Stars was a series of spellbinding outdoor events held in 2022, produced by Pinwheel and DAT Events and commissioned by the North of Tyne Combined Authority. The visual story telling was inspired by local stories and landscapes from across Newcastle, Northumberland and North Tyneside. Encapsulating spectacular projection, fire and music, the event

attracted over 44,000 visitors to the region.

#### ············ Morph

The world's first ever Morph art trail, 'Morph's Epic Art Adventure' hit the streets of North Tyneside from January to April 2022

over 60,000 visitors.

#### Hadrian's Wall 1900

In 2022, Hadrian's Wall 1900 celebrated the 1900th anniversary of the beginning of the construction of Hadrian's Wall. Over 3,000 individual events took place throughout the year-long celebration.





#### Illuminated Sheep

A visual arts trail lit up Northumberland in Autumn 2022 to celebrate the arrival of the Lindisfarne Gospels in the North East that attracted over 270,000 people.



#### Rugby League World Cup 2022

The Rugby League World Cup 2022 started in Newcastle and brought a cultural festival to kickstart the tournament. Ahead of the opening fixture at St James Park, an outdoor performance brought the Rugby League World Cup onto the streets of Newcastle. This specially commissioned free show, featured dance, music and aerial performance, tells three unique stories about the game and its people, charting how it has evolved from its roots to the sport it is today.



#### **Lindisfarne Gospels**

The Lindisfarne Gospels' celebrates the most spectacular surviving manuscript from early medieval Britain. The exhibition ran from September to December 2022 and attracted over 56,000 visitors.



#### North Sea Weekender

Thousands of people attended the 2022 North Sea Weekender which was held along the stunning North Tyneside coast. Activities included the Tynemouth Surf Open, an opportunity to participate in a range of water sports, pop-up food and drink stalls and live music events.




#### **Dark Skies Star Trails**

Northumberland officially has the most pristine dark skies in England; on a clear night, you can see thousands of stars, the Milky Way and even the Andromeda Galaxy with the naked eye.

Partnerships between visitor attractions, accommodation providers and activity suppliers are offering products to visitors to experience the ultimate Dark Sky adventure.

Inspired by the legends and landscapes of the North of Tyne region, the six installations took visitors on a journey through the history and culture of the north east.

From an enormous zoetrope powered by the inventiveness of the region, to a collection of ethereal, ghostly creatures and an ever-changing magic carpet of intricate patterns inspired by Geordie culture, these enchanting works played out across the city's iconic buildings and streets.

The festival proved popular with visitors, with thousands of people enjoying the event over four nights, from Thursday 10 to Sunday 13 March 2022.

#### The 40th Great North Run

The 40th Great North Run was delivered with funding from the North of Tyne Combined Authority.

Due to COVID restrictions the world's largest half marathon had a brand new route with the course starting and finishing in Newcastle City Centre, changes to the start were also made, in order to keep participants as safe as possible on the day.

As part of the celebrations, The Great North Thank You Campaign, was launched and featured 13 inspirational individuals in a large-scale visual installation along the route of the course. For each mile of the Great North Run, Great North Heroes were selected and celebrated for their contribution to the local community during the country's battle with COVID. They included NHS Staff, Fundraisers, Teachers, Coaches, Care Workers and Mental Health Champions.

# **Culture and Creative Investment Programme**

An early stage creative SME based in Newcastle, has secured a loan investment from the North of Tyne Culture and Creative Investment Programme in partnership with Creative UK. Tiny Dragon Productions has been awarded a loan of £25,000 via the Creative Boost strand of the North of Tyne Culture and Creative Investment Programme to finance the purchase of key equipment that will build their capacity and catalyse their first full trading year.

#### **Arcus Studios**

A multi-award-winning animation and multimedia company based in Newcastle upon Tyne, has received a £150,000 investment from the North of Tyne Culture and Creative Investment Programme. Having worked with clients such as the BBC, E4 and the McMillan Trust since forming in 2010, the capital injection will provide support for cashflow stability, capacity building through staff team expansion and value addition through enhanced financial governance.


